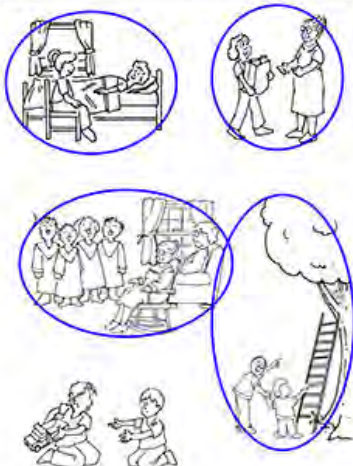

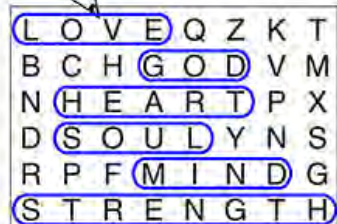

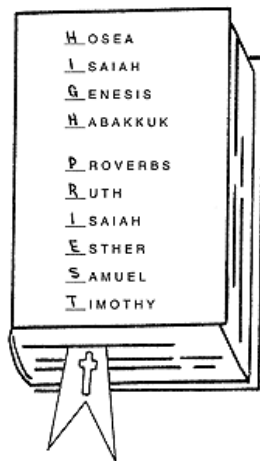
Jesus provided a sacrifice for sin better than all others.
