

Temporary Tennis/Pickleball Restrictions Due to Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic

General

- Members must be free of any symptoms of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in order to visit the Club.
- Only members of the same household may play tennis together at this time.
- The Bubble will remain closed at this time.
- Advanced court reservations must be made by emailing tennisshop@wedgewoodgolfcc.com.
- No guest play at this time.
- Members are asked to remain at least 6 feet away from one another.
- Seating areas will be removed for the time being.
- Water dispensers will be removed. Please bring drinking water with you from home.
- Towels will not be provided, please bring a towel from home.
- Private and group instruction is not permitted at this time.

Sanitation

- We ask members to use provided hand sanitizer upon entering the courts.
- Staff members will be regularly disinfecting restrooms, nets and Pro Shop.

Play

- Avoid touching your face after handling a ball, racquet or other equipment. Wash your hands promptly if you have touched your eyes, nose or mouth.
- Avoid sharing food, drinks or towels.
- Use your racquet/foot to pick up balls and hit them to your opponent. Avoid using your hands to pick up the balls.
- Stay on your side of court. Avoid changing ends of the court.
- No extra-curricular or social activity should take place.

Tennis / Pickleball Balls

- For recreational play, members are asked to bring their own balls, or purchase balls from the Pro Shop. Balls are not able to be borrowed from the Pro Shop at this time.
- Each player must use individually identifiable balls for play, preferably with a number. When serving, only use your own identified ball. Proceed with play, making sure to pick up your set of numbered balls only.
- Should a ball with a number other than yours wind up on your side of the court, do not touch the ball with your hands.
- Use your racquet head or feet to advance the ball to the other side of the court.
