SUSPECT CASE? CONTACT PUBLIC HEALTH



WHY SHOULD YOU REPORT SUSPECT CASES OF NOTIFIABLE DISEASES?

The sooner we know, the sooner we can act.

Early reporting allows Public Health to:

-  Coordinate testing and results with the lab, the attending/ordering healthcare provider and follow up with patients.
-  Conduct case investigation and follow-up with a suspect or confirmed case.
-  Start contact tracing to identify those individuals at highest risk (infants, children, pregnant people and immunocompromised).
-  Identify contacts that will benefit from post exposure immunization/antibiotics.
