Who will complete training

Training approach

- Training is **self-directed** and available through [My Administrative Portal \(MAP\)](#)
- Modules focus on **new workflow steps** introduced in Wave 2
- Training builds on knowledge from the initial MIRM training phase

Training expectations

- Training is role-specific and aligned to updated workflows
- **Three steps are required to gain access:**
 - Complete eLearning (MAP)
 - Submit training acknowledgement (Resource Below)
 - Submit a user access request (Resource below)

Please note: Users only need to submit an access request if they do not already have access.
- **All required training must be completed by Friday, May 8, 2026**
