Abram was 99 years old and he and Sarai had no children. God spoke to Abram. “I am God, the mighty God. Stay with me. I promise that you will have children. Your children will have many children, and they will have many children. This will be an everlasting promise.”

Abram fell to the ground in the presence of God. God continued, "Because I will make you the head of many people and nations, you will now be called Abraham. I will be your God, and you and all the people who come after you will be my people."
