

Crossing the Jordan River

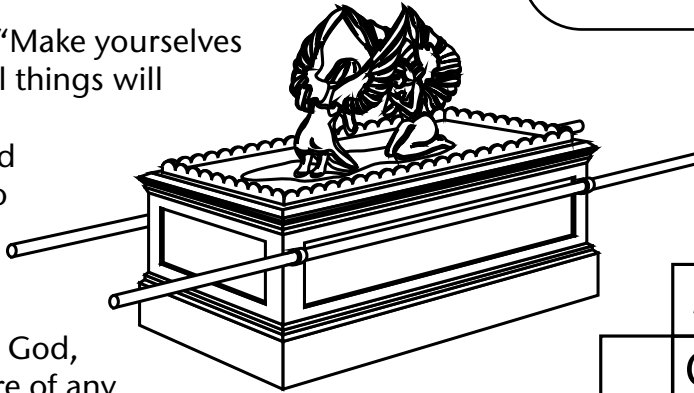
based on Joshua 3:7-17
