





BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE BILL

Information for Local Governments and Agencies

President Biden signed the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) into law in November 2021. This legislation will provide \$1.2 trillion in funding to improve our nation's infrastructure.

Texas will receive \$35.44 billion over five years.



THE PRIORITIES FOR USING THESE FUNDS ARE:

- Repair and rebuild roads
- Transportation
- Expanding network of chargers for electric vehicles
- Broadband access
- Prepare infrastructure for impacts of climate change, cyber attacks, and extreme weather
