6	<b>Memorial of Blesseds Miguel Léibar Garay, Florencio Arnáiz Cejudo, Joaquín Ochoa Salazar, and Sabrino Ayastuy Errasti</b>	<p><i>Father Miguel Léibar and Brothers Florencio Arnáiz, Sabino Ayastuy and Joaquín Ochoa were members of the Society of Mary in Spain, all dedicated teachers respected by colleagues and students. When the religious persecution broke out at the time of the Civil War in Spain, they hid in the homes of friends. Father Miguel was arrested on July 28, 1936, and shot by the revolutionary militia. Several weeks later, Brothers Florencio, Sabino and Joaquín were shot as well. They were beatified by Pope Benedict XVI in 2007.</i></p> <p style="text-align: right;">NACMS website</p>
