- Professional Skill-Building: Gain experience in group decision-making, strategic planning, program development, and intergenerational collaboration.
- Marianist Connections: Deepen your understanding of the Marianist charism and identity, connect with Marianists across the US, and find community in the Catholic Church with those that want to advance justice.
- Training Opportunities: MSJC sponsors volunteer training in antiracism, restorative practices, and other social justice areas.
- Annual Gathering: Every 12-18 months, Justice Teams gather in person. MSJC covers lodging and meals as well as provides financial support to any volunteer attending that needs it.

Volunteer Responsibilities:

- Attend monthly or bi-monthly virtual team meetings (varies by team)
- Support program development, facilitation, and implementation (teams typically run 2-4 programs per year)
- Stay engaged with emerging information and resources to help shape team programs and goals
- **Time Commitment**: Average 2-5 hours per month. We ask new volunteers to commit to a 1 year term.
