Ann is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker and has focused on community mental health, non-profit counseling agencies, and Hospice care. Presently, she is a psychotherapist with Centus Counseling which received a grant from the Rose Community Foundation for Education. Ann's specialties include: working with adult trauma survivors, grief/loss, senior/geriatric work, end-of-life issues, relationship issues, life transitions, self-esteem, stress management, anxiety, depression, and spiritual direction. We will welcome Ann's approach to therapy which is holistic in nature. What affects our minds, affects our emotions, our bodies, our spiritual self, and our relationships with others. She follows the premise that we as human beings are whole at our core.
