

Funding Opportunity for Non-profits and Social Impact Organizations

Dear Valued Partner,

We are reaching out to you on behalf of the Highlands Lutheran Endowment. We provide small grants to non-profits that support programs in and around Denver Metro area and/or that serve greater Colorado, which are focused on youth, LGBTQ, people who are unhoused/homeless, Indigenous/Native American communities, prison programs, and food banks. We are specifically focused on projects that bring hope, healing, and hospitality in these areas.

We are providing an additional round of grants before the end of the year to assist with a number of budget shortfalls and stresses that organizations are going through right now. Awarded grants usually range between \$1,000 and \$5,000.

To apply please submit an application through one of two ways.

- Via the online form found on the website, which is the easiest and will go directly to us.
- By downloading the application, filling it out either directly on your computer or by printing it out filling it out by hand, scanning it in, and sending it to the following email address: endowment@highlandslutheran.org

The deadline for submission of applications for this additional funding round is Friday Nov 21, 2025.

- We ask that questions regarding the grant application process or application itself be submitted by **Wednesday Nov 12, 2025**, to the following email address: endowment@highlandslutheran.org
- Questions should be submitted in either a separate PDF document or entered directly into the body of the email.
- We will consolidate all questions from all potential grantees, draft a separate response document to all relevant questions, and then send the responses out to all applicants via email at one time on **Friday Nov 14, 2025**.
