

## **DIRECTIONS** (from Denver):

3056 CO Rd 198, Nathrop, CO 81236

Take I-25 south to Colorado Springs and Exit 140. Go straight off the exit, following signs for Nevada Ave. Turn right on 115/Nevada Ave. towards Canon City. Go approximately 34 miles south on Hwy 115 to Penrose. Exit onto Hwy 50 and go 11 miles west to Canon City. Stay on Hwy 50 for another 26 miles to Texas Creek. Turn on Hwy 69 and go 11 miles south to Hillside. Follow the blue Rainbow Trail Lutheran Camp sign, turning right onto gravel road just after Hillside. Then follow the camp signs for the next 4 miles.
