## Invitation to Join the Formation Co-Op: A Journey of Listening, Trust, and Transformation!

Greetings from **Sky Ranch Lutheran Camp** and the Formation Co-Op!

We are excited to invite your congregation to be part of the <u>Formation Co-Op</u>, a collaborative initiative of the <u>ELCA Youth Ministry Network</u> in partnership with the ELCA, supported by a four-year Lilly Grant.

The Formation Co-Op partners with congregations to explore innovative youth ministry practices to root young people in a lifelong, transformative faith in Jesus Christ. We are now launching Group C, the final phase of the grant, and we are doing so in a regional hub model in collaboration with five Lutheran Outdoor Ministry sites. **Sky Ranch Lutheran Camp** is proud to serve as one of these hub sites.

## **What Participation Looks Like**

Each hub (including ours) will gather 4–5 congregations into a local cohort. Together, these Congregation Teams will:

- Attend four in-person Co-Op Training Retreats, 2 @ at Sky Ranch Lutheran Camp, and 2 down the mountain in a centralized location, guided by our staff.
- Engage in monthly team meetings using provided resources and agendas.
- Conduct listening sessions with youth, leaders, and their wider faith community.
- Explore and implement innovative approaches to youth ministry for their context.

This is not a plug-and-play curriculum or program. Instead, the Co-Op offers a framework and a set of guiding commitments that help each congregation shape ministry that is both faithful and contextual.

## Is Your Congregation Ready?

The Co-Op does ask for commitment, curiosity, and collaboration. To help you assess your congregation's readiness for this work, we encourage you to complete the <u>Congregation Readiness Assessment Tool</u> with your key leaders before applying. This is not a test — it's a discernment tool to help you start the conversations that will lay a strong foundation for your Co-Op journey.
