**Smart TV/Apple TV/Roku/Amazon Fire/Most TV Stream Devices:**

1. Install the YouTube app if you do not already have it.
2. To install, you may need to use the App Store (or equivalent) on your device.
3. Navigate to the "Archbishop's Virtual Gala" livestream using the search bar in the YouTube app.
4. Click and enjoy!

**iPhone/iPad:**

1. Install the YouTube app if you do not already have it.
2. To install, you may need to use the App Store on your device.
3. Navigate to the "Archbishop's Virtual Gala" livestream using the search bar in the YouTube app.
4. Click and enjoy!

**Samsung Screen Share - Android:**

1. Must be a Samsung TV and Android device.
2. Make sure your phone and TV are on the same WiFi network.
3. Open the Quick Settings panel by swiping down with two fingers from the top of the screen.
4. Swipe to find the "Smart View" icon, tap it (you may need to enter a pin or press "allow" on your TV).
5. Open your web browser and navigate to "Youtube.com".
6. Search for "Archbishop's Virtual Gala" livestream using the search bar at the top of the page.

## **Samsung Screen Share – Windows 10 PC**

1. Must be a Samsung TV and Windows 10 PC.
2. Make sure your computer and TV are on the same WiFi network.
3. On your PC, click “Start” then “Settings”.
4. In Settings, click “Devices” then “Bluetooth & other devices”.
5. Next, click “Add Bluetooth or other device” then “Wireless display or dock”.
6. Click on your TV name once it appears and press “Allow” on your TV.
7. Open your web browser and navigate to “Youtube.com”.
8. Search for “Archbishop’s Virtual Gala” livestream using the search bar at the top of the page

## **Windows Computer to TV with HDMI:**

1. Plug one end of the HDMI cable into your computer.
2. Plug the other end into an “HDMI In” port on your TV.
3. Switch your TV’s input to the correct HDMI In channel using the source button.
4. Press “Windows Key + P” to view display settings with the TV connected.
5. Left click the speaker icon in the bottom right corner of your Window’s desktop and make sure that HDMI is selected. If you see “Speakers” or something else showing up, left click the name and choose “HDMI”.
6. Open your web browser and navigate to “Youtube.com”.
7. Search for “Archbishop’s Virtual Gala” livestream using the search bar at the top of the page.

## **Apple Computer to TV with HDMI:**

1. Plug one end of the HDMI cable into your computer’s HDMI port. (May need an HDMI to Thunderbolt or Mini-DP adapter, depending on your computer’s model)
2. Plug the other end into an “HDMI-In” port on your TV.
3. Switch your TV’s input to the correct HDMI-In channel using the source button.
4. Open “System Preferences” on your dock.
5. Click on “Displays”.
6. Select “HDMI” in the dropdown “Optimize for” menu.
7. You can select screen mirroring or extended screen.
8. In “System Preferences”, click “Sound”.
9. Make sure that the Output Tab is selected.
10. Choose “HDMI” as the sound output device.
11. Open your web browser and navigate to “Youtube.com”.
12. Search for “Archbishop’s Virtual Gala” livestream using the search bar at the top of the page.
