# *Costume Information Spring 2019*

**Please submit your fee to the Cape Cod Dance Center by:  
Saturday March 16th, 2019**

Costumes for the Spring Ballet “*Sleeping Beauty*” will need to be purchased for students enrolled in **Pre-Ballet & Ballet 1 (with & without Tap) & Ballet 2 thru 4** for a fee of **\$58 per costume** and will be yours to keep after the performances.

Costumes for students enrolled in **Ballet 5 & 6** will be pulled from Cape Cod Dance Center Wardrobe Inventory and/or rented from professional companies. A fee of **\$40** will be charged to each student to cover all alterations, improvements, and rental costs.

Costumes for the Spring Recital “*In Memoriam*” will need to be purchased for students enrolled in all classes. Students in **Hip Hop & All Contemporary Dance Classes** will need only one costume. Your costume fee will be **\$58** and will be yours to keep after the performances.

**Three** costumes will need to be purchased for the Spring Recital “*In Memoriam*” for students enrolled in the **Lyrical/Jazz/Tap combo classes on Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays**. Your costume fee is **\$120** and all three costumes will be yours to keep after the performance.

Additional items may need to be purchased for the recital such as dance shoes, skin color leotards, and tights. Most items can be purchased through the studio **Dance Bin**. Refer to the list below for information regarding shoes, tights and other accessories needed. **All costumes will be brought to the theater for the dress rehearsal and performances.**

**No nail polish, jewelry or body tattoos allowed when performing on stage. No color hair elastics. Hair should be worn in a bun for students in ballet & tap and all ballet levels. All other students are asked to wear their hair in a high pony tail (right above the top of the ear).**

# *Backstage Etiquette Handout Spring 2019*

*To ensure that this is a positive experience for everyone involved we wish to share some basic theater etiquettes and backstage rules pertinent to each one so we can better work together.*

***Once your child is dropped off at the theater, the backstage mothers are responsible for their care and safety. Each student must be signed in and out. Please make it known that there will be someone different at pick up. We are also asking that a contact number be left at drop-off with the backstage coordinators.***

## ***Backstage***

*Backstage help is always needed during the rehearsals and performances at the theater. Volunteer backstage moms are there to take care of the classroom, help with make-up, and to set-up calm games. Two backstage mothers are needed per level for each performance. We recommend for all backstage mothers to be present during the dress rehearsal to answer any last minute questions. The better prepared all backstage mothers are, the easier it is for everyone. (More information on the **Volunteer Information Sheet**)*

## ***Non-Backstage Parents***

*We gently ask parents who are not helping backstage to stay outside the classrooms. Parents are requested to drop-off their dancers on time and pick them up when the performance is completed. No one other than the volunteers should be backstage with the dancers during the performances and preparation time unless your child requires special attention.*

## ***What happens backstage?***

*While students are not rehearsing or performing on stage they remain in the classrooms. The time backstage is spent primarily getting ready for performance: applying make-up, getting dressed, warming-up, and going over the dances.*

*Here are other things parents may want to send along with their child to help spend time and be comfortable backstage:*

- 1. Quiet games, cards, math games, coloring tools (no markers)*
- 2. Healthy snacks, fruits (NO orange colored or greasy snacks)*
- 3. Water only, no Gatorade or colored drinks*

## ***Other important backstage information:***

- 1. Dancers should be sent to the theater with a clean face. Volunteers and backstage moms will help prepare the students for the performances*
- 2. Hair should be done in a bun with hairnet and spray. If you are unable to fix your kids hair in a bun, please do a simple ponytail, we'll take care of the rest*
- 3. There is Absolutely NO eating in costumes!*
- 4. It is forbidden to run in the halls or out in the audience*
- 5. Everyone needs to use the bathroom before intermission*

*There will be a backstage coordinator that can answer most of your questions. Backstage volunteers will meet prior to the performances to go over basic information and overall logistics of the show.*

# *Volunteer Information 2019*

The participation of all our volunteers are what makes our performances possible year after year. Here are the **VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES:**

**Poster Distribution:** Involves distributing posters around the Bourne, Falmouth, Mashpee and Sandwich area as needed. (4 weeks prior to the performance)

**Costumes:** Involves participating in various tasks including: steaming, repairing, and fixing various parts of our costumes and props.  
(6 weeks prior to the performance)

**Baking:** Bringing in baked goods for our bake sale during the performances.

**Ticket Sales:** Involves taking care of ticket tables, selling tickets, and handing out reserved tickets. (Reserve 30 minutes before show time)

**Bake Sale:** Involves setting up the baked goods and facilitating sales.  
(Prepare table before show starts and sell during the intermission)

**Usher:** Ushers welcome the audience at the doors, ensures that everyone has a ticket, hand out programs, and take notice that folks do not bring food or drinks into the auditorium. (Reserve 30 minutes before show time)

**Backstage Moms:** Backstage help is always needed during rehearsals and performances at the theater. Volunteer backstage moms are there to take care of the classrooms, help with make-up, and set-up calm games. Interested parents are asked to contact **Charnette Buckhoff** or sign-up on the backstage help list which will be posted in the spring.  
(Volunteers should be backstage with the dancers during the performances and preparation time)

**Costume Load-In:** Involves gathering all costumes from the studio and bringing them to the Bourne High School. The responsible parents will make sure all costumes are brought to the theater in appropriate containers and are ready to be used (which means laid down or hung). All costumes will be brought to the theater for dress rehearsal **on Friday June 13<sup>th</sup> from 10am to 2pm.**

**Production Load-In:** Involves taking all scenery, portable floor, and back-drops from the studio/ storage in Cataumet to the Bourne High School **on Friday June 13<sup>th</sup> from 10am to 2pm.**

**Production Load-Out:** Involves taking all CCDC costumes, scenery, portable floor, and back-drops back to the Cataumet studio **after the performance on Sun. June 16<sup>th</sup> from 5pm to 7pm.**

**A volunteer sign-up sheet will be posted at the studio in May. Let us know how you would like to help.**
