- Reside in the greater Hudson area
- Applicant shall exhibit a positive impact through volunteering and giving back to the community by actively contributing their time and talent to help others while leading through example in academics, athletics or service activities.

The following items must be included to complete your application: *Deadline: January 31st*

- This completed Application, use as your cover page
- Current High School Transcript
- Character reference from school, work and other (more than one reference letter is recommended for higher score)
- Resume/Summary of community service activities, extracurricular activities, work history
- An essay (no more than 500 words) on one of the following topics: Community, Civic Responsibility, or Leadership

Scoring of the applicants by the Selection Committee: *All application will be reviewed based on the following:*

- A. Community Involvement:
 - School Activities (up to 10 points.)
 - Community Involvement & Volunteerism (up to 15 points)
- B. Scholastic Record: (up to 10 points.)
- C. Work Demands/History (up to 15 points)
- D. Recommendations (2 or more recommendations = 20 pts; 1 recommendation = 15 pts)
- E. Essay (under 500 words) about Community, Civic Responsibility or Leadership (up to 30 points)

The monetary award presented to the student(s) is intended for use toward college expenses, including the purchase of books or other materials required for post-secondary education.
