(5 facts as listed by US News & World Report)

- 1** The average life expectancy of a homeless person is just **50 years**.
- 2** **39.8%** of homeless persons are African Americans.
- 3** **61%** of homeless persons are men and boys.
- 4** **20%** of homeless persons are kids.
- 5** **42%** of street children identify as LGBT.

Did you know that approximately 17 people per 10,000 experience homelessness each day?



“With 552,830 US individuals living in a state of homelessness, things are just not looking great. Still, it is a small percentage compared to the overall US population — which counts over 327.2 million.” (source: Whitehouse)
