I share with those who are a-thirst the well-springs of my soul!





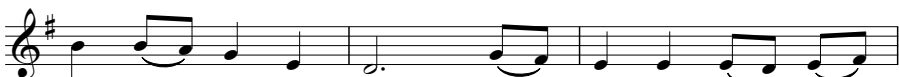
