

Help Get Out The Vote with “UU the Vote” Join a Letter Writing Campaign

We, **the UUCSW Social Justice Committee**, are participating in a “UU The Vote” letter writing campaign to encourage lapsed voters in targeted states to vote in this year’s presidential election. Join us and we will give you voter names, addresses and standardized voter-specific letters that you will personalize by handwriting your reason for voting. People can typically complete 20 letters in an hour to an hour-and-a-half.

Here's the Executive Summary:

Marge Fisher & Jerry Breecher will sign up through UU The Vote with the sponsoring organization, VoteForward. They will download lists of voters and will email you a PDF of the voter-specific letters which you will print. VoteForward is tracking which voters are 'adopted' so it is important that we pay attention to detail.

Participating includes providing printing, envelopes, stamps – and of course encouragement to vote. (If the cost of stamps is an issue, the Social Justice Committee can provide postage.)

- Aug 25: Commit date from writers (that's you)

- Sep 6: After-church kickoff virtual letter-writing party (optional)
(Same Zoom link as church service)
- Sep 13: Letters ready to go and DO NOT mail until Social Justice gives you a 'put in the mail' date. (VoteForward is monitoring the U.S. Postal situation and will tell us when to mail the letters).
