

## ADMISSIONS OVERVIEW

Our online application system allows students to manage their application process. Review the steps below for a quick overview of the process.

### 1. PREPARE ADMISSION CHECKLIST ITEMS

**To expedite a faculty review of an application, students may upload the following items:**

- Admission Essay
- Student copies of transcripts from every college/university attended
- Student copies of GRE scores\* GRE: Verbal: 150-170, Writing: 3.7-6
- Request letters of recommendation—after submitting the application, students will need to provide their recommender's name and email address in order to complete the request process.
- Evidence of NYS teaching certification

\* Full admission **REQUIRES** the submission of official transcripts and test scores.

SUNY New Paltz students and Alumni are NOT required to submit an official transcript.

- **Literacy Education B-6 (Rockland) Program ID: 30AR**
- **Literacy Education 5-12 (Rockland) Program ID: 30BR**

### 2. CREATE AN ACCOUNT

1. **SUNY New Paltz** students and alumni may access the application system by logging into [my.newpaltz.edu](http://my.newpaltz.edu) with their New Paltz credentials (NPCUID) and selecting the "Graduate Studies" link.
2. **NEW** students may create an account by selecting the New User option and verifying their email address.
3. **RETURNING** users may access the application system using their email address and password that was included when creating their account.

### 3. SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

- Once you have logged into the system, select the term that you would like to begin your program.  
**NOTE:** Certain programs restrict admission to a specific term. Please email [gradstudies@newpaltz.edu](mailto:gradstudies@newpaltz.edu) if you do not see the program that you would like to pursue.
