

Pathway to Become a Safeguarding Trainer in the Diocese of Olympia

1. One must be approved by the Local Rector/Vicar/Priest-in-Charge and/or Sr. Warden (in the absence of a Rector/Vicar/Priest-in-Charge).
2. Attend a Safeguarding training as a participant. Trainings are listed at <https://resources.ecww.org/safe-church>.
3. Lead a subsequent Safeguarding Training with an already approved Trainer in attendance. (You may contact the Office of the Bishop if you are not already connected to a Trainer that can attend.)
4. The Mentor Trainer will provide a letter to the Office of Bishop stating that the person has completed all of the above. This can be emailed to acaballero@ecww.org.
5. The Office of Bishop will then issue a certificate naming this person a trainer.

This process must be done for both Children & People if one wishes to become a Trainer for both trainings.
