



Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK) (Registration starts March 1)

Voluntary Pre-K for the 2018-19 school year is available for any child who is **4 years of age on or before September 1, 2018**. Participants must reside in Seminole County. The State of Florida provides for 540 hours of instruction, three hours per day, which is free to the parent.

Parents may choose a 3 hour Half Day VPK Program, either AM or PM, a Hybrid Program where there is space available for full or half day students OR a full day program if their child needs full day care. For the full day sites, once the free 3 hour VPK block is over, a \$310 per month tuition is charged for the remainder of the school day. **Transportation is not provided.**

Seminole County Public Schools VPK programs are offered at various school locations throughout the district. You do not have to attend your zoned school unless indicated below.

To register your child for VPK at a Seminole County School, bring your Certificate of Eligibility, along with the documents listed below, to the Pre-K Office located at 239 Rinehart Rd., Lake Mary, FL 32746. Individual schools will not be registering for VPK. The Pre-K Office is open between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM Monday-Friday. Children will be placed on a waiting list until all documents are received. Once registration packet is complete, the child will be placed on the class list if space is available. An exception will be made for the Immunization Record and Proof of Physical which must be received by August 1.
