

The rising cost of health insurance is very concerning to me, especially in light of COVID-19.

Senate Bill 2676 sponsored by Senator Joe Vitale (D-Middlesex) and Assembly Bill 4389 sponsored by Assemblyman John McKeon (D-Essex) would assess a 2.75% tax on every health policy sold in New Jersey. The proceeds from the tax will be deposited into a new fund titled the "Health Insurance Affordability Fund (HIAF)."

Taxing a product to make it more affordable just doesn't make any sense. This tax will certainly increase the cost of my health insurance. I cannot afford another increase in health care costs right now.
