Pajama Pass Rules & Procedures

Throughout the week, teachers may select students to whom they award pajama passes for behavior guidelines listed on passes. (excellent citizenship, respectfulness, kindness, being on time to class etc.) This is a positive way for us to acknowledge excellent student behavior and build student morale.

Between class or at lunchtime, the student who received the pass must turn in the pass to the MS office.

Office staff will enter the recipient student names onto a spreadsheet

Students who are awarded a pass, must come to the office on Thursday morning to get a stamp showing that they are allowed to wear PJs that day.

Thursday is the only designated PJ day.

THOU SHALL:

Be a good citizen and treat one another with kindness and respect.

Be glad for others when they are awarded the pass.

Be appreciative and thankful when recognized for your positive behavior.

Understand that doing the right thing is its own reward. This is just for fun!



THOU SHALL NOT:

Ask teachers for pajama passes - that will disqualify the student from earning one for one week

Attempt to take or coerce another student to give his/her pass away - that will disqualify the student from earning a pass for two weeks

Wear pajamas without having been authorized to do so - that will disqualify the student for two weeks and earn the student disciplinary action

Wear slippers with pajamas. Appropriate footwear is required for safety.

Rub it in other students' faces if a pajama pass was earned. - student will lose the pajama wearing privilege and be disqualified from earning another one for two weeks
