



Upon clicking on "Create Account", you will see a screen like that shown below.






Powerschool can be setup to automatically alert you of your child's grades, attendance, lunch money funds, etc. You can adjust the frequency with which you receive these announcements.


Moodle



Students - Enrolling in a Moodle Course

- Students will login using the same credentials that they use for Powerschool; their username is their student ID number. If a student is lacking this information, please see the office after this presentation.
- Upon login, clicking the drop-down arrow in the upper right, students can access their dashboard. (see image below)
- Moodle is arranged into classes. These are displayed at the dashboard. Students will need to **enroll in each of the courses they have in their daily course schedule (Bible, Math, English, etc.) separately.**


Prior to enrolling in her various courses, a student will have very little to do in Moodle. So, we need to know how to enroll in a course.

After logging in to moodle, a student should scroll all the way down to the bottom of the page and see a search box, as in the following image.



Students - Enrolling in a Moodle Course

From here, a student should click on the school in which they are enrolled, VCMS if middle school or VCHS if high school. The school name will expand to show various courses. The student will need to find the one she wishes to enroll in and click on it. If the course cannot be found, she may need to click on "view more."



Below I have clicked on "Bible 7" as an example. You can see the page that I am taken to. You see under "Enrollment options", both "Guest access" and "SelfEnroll". The former is for parents, while the latter is for students.



Note the "Enrollment key". This is a password that the student needs to get from their instructor. They will type it in the box and click the red "ENROLL ME" button below the box. This will enroll the student in the course. Now the course can be accessed from the dashboard, as shown previously.

- **Parents will NOT enroll in moodle courses.** Parents access moodle via the "guest access" option.

VCS-provided Gmail account

- VCS provides every student with a Gmail account at the domain go-vcs.com
- The student's email address will be their student ID number followed by "@go-vcs.com". For example: 12345@go-vcs.com
- This email address works similar to a typical Gmail account, so students will need to login at gmail.com in a web browser or download and login to any of a number of apps Google maintains in its app suite, for instance Gmail, Google Sheets, Google Drive, etc.
- Students have a massive amount of free cloud storage available to them in Google Drive by way of this email address. We very much want them to use this cloud storage, their school-provided email account, and any of Google's apps that they may find useful.
- Students need to be checking their school-provided email daily, as their teachers will use these email addresses to communicate with them and inform the students of important matters.
- Please note: Whenever students email VCS staff members, they must use their school-provided email account.
- Teachers will be using many of the Google apps to share documents and other digital resources with students. It is very important that students login to their school-provided accounts when accessing these resources. Failure to do so will prevent the students from accessing materials that they need for the academic course and hinder their success in the classroom.



iPads

- Though 6th and 7th graders will NOT need them, each student enrolled in grades 8 through 12 will need an iPad for her individual academic use.
- Provision of the iPad is the responsibility of the student and her family. VCS will NOT provide iPads to students.
- At VCS, iPads are to be treated as any other piece of classroom equipment (think pencils, calculators, etc.). They are tools to be used for academic success, not sources of distraction.
- The middle school and high school campuses are equipped with WiFi that the students may use while on campus to assist in their academic flourishing.
- Students in grades 8 through 12 must bring their iPads with them to campus daily, just like any other piece of equipment needed for class.
- iPads are to be charged nightly at home so that low batteries do not hinder classroom success.
- The aforementioned suite of Google Apps (Gmail, Google Drive, Google Docs, etc.) makes the iPad a powerful and invaluable means of completing coursework.
- The specifics of how iPads are used will vary from course to course and teacher to teacher.
