Rent-to-Own Program Requirements

VCS offers a musical instrument program for all students grades 3 through 12. A monthly fee is charged for the rental of the instrument (with the exception of the recorder option, which incurs a one-time fee for instant ownership.) Under this plan, after four (4) full years/48 months in the Instrumental Music Program, with the same instrument, your child will own that instrument. If the student changes instruments at any time during the 48-month period, the 4 year/48 month time period will begin again. Only months during which you are paying for the instrument count towards the 48-month period. (i.e. If you choose to turn in the instrument during the summer, these

months will not count toward the 48-month period towards ownership of the instrument.)

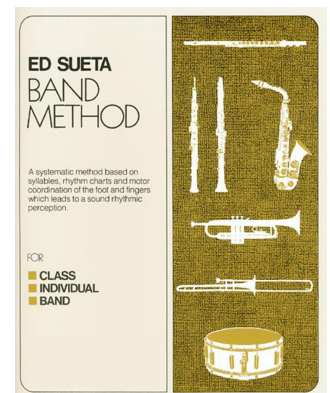
Fees are due for the entire month for any month you have the instrument in your possession for any portion of the month. Instruments returned to the Conservatory in good working order prior to the last day will not be billed for the next month.

The Instrumental Music Program fees are billed through Smart Tuition. Payments are due on the 1st day of the month and are delinquent on the 10th day of the month. A late fee will be charged for all past due amounts. You are responsible for making all payments when due.

If the instrument is lost, stolen or damaged, you are responsible for its repair or replacement. This includes cosmetic repairs to the finish of the instrument. *If there is damage to the instrument, we will have it brought back to play condition and your account will be charged for necessary repairs.*

Books and Accessories

Initial accessories will be provided, but many accessories (reeds, valve oil, etc.) will need to be replaced over time. You will be responsible for replacement after the initial supply is exhausted. Limited accessories and books are available for purchase at the school. Families may choose to purchase accessories and Ed Sueta method books as students progress, or these will be provided by the school and billed to your account. Please note that access to both an instrument and a book are required for class.
