General Information

The award is given to an Elk who has truly distinguished himself/herself in promoting the principles and programs of Elksdom. The candidate should also have a history of service to his/her community, state and our country.

The Thad Eure Distinguished Service Award Committee will be composed of the sitting Board of Directors of the North Carolina State Elks Association, Inc., to include its exofficio members, the State Association President and President Elect.

- (1) It is not mandatory that all the sections above be completed; however, all information submitted will be considered in the selection of the most qualified candidate.
- (2) All resumes will be held for three years from the time of submission unless the candidate is selected before that time expires. All resumes may be updated each year if additional information is pertinent.
- (3) It is not mandatory that the award be given each year, regardless of the number of resumes on file.

Submission

The nomination of the candidate should be approved by the home lodge of the nominee prior to submission of the resume to the Board of Directors for consideration. The resume should be sent to the North Carolina State Association Director from the same District as the nominee. The resume should be sent prior to February 15th of the year that the resume is initially submitted. The resume may be hand delivered, submitted by mail or submitted electronically.
