

Italian Dinner to Raise Funds for the Needy Children's Fund

At Mills River Elementary School

The Church of the Holy Family in Mills River has an active outreach ministry to help support the needs of children and adults in the Greater Hendersonville area. Mills River Elementary School is a Title 1 school that includes serving many low-income children who have a variety of unmet needs such as glasses, clothing, and food. Because of this, the school has a **Needy Children's Fund** that helps to meet the needs these children have.

The Outreach Committee of Church of the Holy Family is hosting an Italian Dinner on Friday, September 8, at 6:30 PM to raise dollars for the Needy Children's Fund. The menu will include salad, home-made lasagna including gluten free and vegetarian along with the traditional lasagna, Italian bread, dessert, and coffee and tea. The cost is \$15.00 for adults and \$7.00 for a child's dinner. To raise a maximum amount of funds, several members of the parish are anonymously underwriting the full cost of the dinner so that all dollars raised will go to the special fund at the school. Wine and beer will also be available for a minimum donation of \$5.00 per drink.

In addition to the dinner, there will be entertainment during dinner along with a silent auction. Among several items to be offered at the auction include a beautiful handmade quilt made by Teresa Kelly and a lovely painting by local artist, Clare Sahling, whose paintings are represented in the Gallery at Flat Rock.
