Dr. Anthony Frank, MD, MBA, FACEP, CPE, Chief Medical Officer at Carolinas HealthCare System Blue Ridge, will join Dr. Taylor in the conversation. He will focus on Burke County COVID-19 statistics, where the public can go for testing, how the public can schedule an appointment to receive the vaccine, and how the local healthcare system is striving to meet the demand for services from the public.
