About the workshop:

If we are lucky, we grow old. However, too often we are not prepared for the changes that occur as a result of our aging. The last census recorded that almost 17% of the population were seniors. What people have to discover is that aging involves change, and, therefore, it's important that we discern the spiritual aspects of growing old. Sister Joan Chittister (who wrote a wonderful book about aging), writes, “The truth is that older people tend to come in two flavors: the sour ones and the serene. Retirement may be our best chance to know ourselves and how we are shaped by our relationship to God.” Therefore, the final chapter of our lives is not only a time for recollection, it's also a time for doing the spiritual, internal, and relational work that is left undone.
