This 2-session mini-course draws on Luther's actual words, as he teaches about the Lord's Supper.	<b>Women's Bible Class</b> 9:00 — 10:00 a.m. Mar. 6 - Apr. 10 Open to: Adult women  <i>"The Messianic Psalms"</i>  The 150 psalms in the Bible cover a wide range of topics: confession, praise, thanksgiving, depression, deliverance, and many others. Some, however, have specific prophecies of the coming Messiah. Learn how these psalms find their fulfillment in Christ, particularly during the first Holy Week.		<b>Men's Bible Breakfast</b> 7:45 — 9:00 a.m. Jan. 11, Feb. 8, Mar. 8, Apr. 12, May 10 Open to: Adult men  <i>"Heroes of Faith"</i>  How were Old Testament Christians saved? In the same way we are: by faith in Jesus. This Bible study examines the faith of Old Testament men and women as mentioned in Hebrews 11 and helps participants learn and live from their examples.
