Nass' book <i>End Times: Jesus Is Coming Soon</i> , part of the <i>People's Bible Teachings</i> series, an optional purchase for this course (<i>series continues into 2024</i>). Adult Bible Class 7:00 — 8:00 p.m. Sept. 6 - Nov. 15 Open to: Adults “How to Study the Bible” As Christians, we all know we should be studying the Bible. But how does one go about studying it? How often should you study, and how much of the Bible at a time? How do you decide what parts to study? Learn about Luther's simple Bible-study approach through this 8-week course, with a bonus 3-week course on using tools from the new hymnal as part of your structured study.	Women's Bible Class 9:00 — 10:00 a.m. Nov. 2 - Dec. 21 Open to: Adult women “Esther: Providential Persian Queen” In her book, author Lou Ann Mokwa invites participants along as she examines Esther's epic saga in this 7-week Bible study.
