Enrollment Update

- As of April 24 we have 116 9th grade students enrolled compared to 67 at this time last year.
- We continue to plan for a freshman class of 125 and an overall enrollment of about 425.

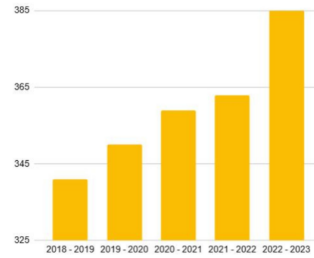
General Board Meeting on May 22nd
