Answering systems	Keyboards
Cable boxes	Mainframe computer equipment
Cables and wires	Medical equipment
Calculators	Mice (the electronic kind!)
Cameras (digital or film)	Paging systems
CD-Rom drives or Zip drives	PDAs
Cell phones	Point of Sale equipment
Circuit boards/semiconductors	Power supplies
Computers: all desktops, laptops, servers, notebooks, accessories, or other hardware	Rack systems
Connectors	Security or surveillance systems
Copiers or printers	Telecommunication equipment
DVD players	Telephones
Floppy drives	Televisions (NO CRTs)
Hard drives	Test equipment
