## INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Isolation Mystery!

This seven step mystery program will make a 42" by 55 1/2" quilt top.

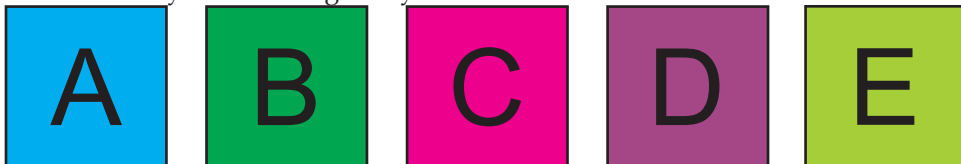
You will need 5 one yard cuts of fabric. You will choose which fabrics are used in each area of your quilt. The fabrics will be referred to as A, B, C, D and E in the instructions. Any fabric can be used in any position. It is up to you to assign the fabrics to their positions. Any combination will work! Here is one small hint: The design will use a bit less of fabrics B and D. You might want to assign your least favorite color or print to those positions.

Backing, batting, binding and borders are NOT included in your kit yardage. Purchasing 1 3/4 yards additional will allow you to add 10" borders for a quilt top measuring 62" by 75 1/2". The smaller throw will require 1/2 yard binding and the version with borders will require 2/3 yard binding.

On the back of this page are the cutting instructions for the entire quilt. Begin by assigning a letter to each of the 5 fabrics in your kit. Cut a small snip of the fabric and tape it to the box next to the instructions. This will help you stay organized as you complete each step.

For consistency in the instructions a color key has been provided. This is not an indication of light/medium/dark and it should only be used for organizational purposes. These colors will remain consistent in your instructions.

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## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

A

### FROM FABRIC A CUT:

- 5 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.  
Cross cut these strips into 48 squares measuring 3 1/2".
- 2 strips 6 1/2" by the width of the fabric.  
Cross cut these strips into 31 rectangles measuring 2" by 6 1/2".

B

### FROM FABRIC B CUT:

- 3 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.  
Cross cut these strips into 62 rectangles measuring 2" by 3 1/2".
- 5 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.  
Cross cut these strips into 48 squares measuring 3 1/2"

C

### FROM FABRIC C CUT:

- 5 strips 6 1/2" by the width of the fabric.  
Cross cut these strips into 48 rectangles measuring 3 1/2" by 6 1/2"

D

### FROM FABRIC D CUT:

- 5 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.  
Cross cut these strips into 48 squares measuring 3 1/2".
- 2 strips 2" by the width of the fabric.  
Cross cut these strips into 20 squares measuring 2".

E

### FROM FABRIC E CUT:

- 10 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.  
Cross cut these strips into 96 squares measuring 3 1/2".

### FROM FABRIC A CUT:

5 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 48 squares measuring 3 1/2".

2 strips 6 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 31 rectangles measuring 2" by 6 1/2".

B

### FROM FABRIC B CUT:

3 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 62 rectangles measuring 2" by 3 1/2".

5 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 48 squares measuring 3 1/2"

C

### FROM FABRIC C CUT:

5 strips 6 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 48 rectangles measuring 3 1/2" by 6 1/2"

D

### FROM FABRIC D CUT:

5 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 48 squares measuring 3 1/2".

2 strips 2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 20 squares measuring 2".

E

### FROM FABRIC E CUT:

10 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 96 squares measuring 3 1/2".

### FROM FABRIC A CUT:

5 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 48 squares measuring 3 1/2".

2 strips 6 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 31 rectangles measuring 2" by 6 1/2".

B

### FROM FABRIC B CUT:

3 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 62 rectangles measuring 2" by 3 1/2".

5 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 48 squares measuring 3 1/2"

C

### FROM FABRIC C CUT:

5 strips 6 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 48 rectangles measuring 3 1/2" by 6 1/2"

D

### FROM FABRIC D CUT:

5 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 48 squares measuring 3 1/2".

2 strips 2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 20 squares measuring 2".

E

### FROM FABRIC E CUT:

10 strips 3 1/2" by the width of the fabric.

Cross cut these strips into 96 squares measuring 3 1/2".
