Vestry Updates

- ◆ Bishop Matt had previously temporarily prohibited most churches in our diocese from celebrating Eucharist/Communion. He is now allowing all congregations to offer Worship that includes Communion at the discretion of the clergy person in conjunction with the leadership of the congregation. Services must have at least one other person in addition to the clergy person, but no more than 5 and the fewer households the better. The same small group of people should assist with each service rather than a rotation of people. Members of the congregation may join remotely in spirit and/or by viewing/listening if the service is live streamed or recorded (not required to celebrate the service). At St James participants assisting with the service will be joining in spiritual Communion. This is in accordance with our belief that sacraments (including Communion) are "an outward and visible sign of an inward and spiritual grace". Our online/phone-in Worship will include Communion starting on May 17, with Amma Diane being the only one who will partake of the bread and wine. The same small team that has been helping with our services up to this point will be present to help., but joining in spiritual communion along with the rest of the congregation.
- ◆ Final work is being done on lower level replacement carpet.
- ◆ Our agreement is in place to temporarily host Painting Pathways Clubhouse on our lower level during their construction project. Expected dates to begin moving in is May 18, and may last until November 30.

Your St James Episcopal Church Vestry is having weekly executive session meetings in response to the pandemic, to check in with each other as leadership of the congregation and to respond as quickly as possible to changes due to COVID-19 that could affect St James and our congregation. The next regular public meeting date is to be determined.

CARES Act charitable giving benefits

The CARES (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security) Act, signed into law on March 27, includes several provisions that benefit charitable giving. Beginning in 2020, individuals can deduct up to \$300 in charitable contributions from their gross income even if they do not itemize deductions. For 2020, the cap on itemized deductions for cash contributions is lifted, from 60% up to 100% of their income, a significant tax savings for anyone able to contribute larger amounts. Gifts of appreciated securities, and gifts to a donor advised fund or supporting organization, do not qualify for these benefits. These benefits are intended to encourage people to continue to support non-profit organizations, including churches, during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Several people have asked ways they can continue to financially support St James when we are not gathering in person. You can still mail checks to St James Episcopal Church, 434 N 8th St, Manitowoc, WI 54220. Contributions are being regularly counted and deposited. You can also set up one-time or recurring payments through your bank (most offer this for free). Look for "bill pay" or similar options online or call your bank. We know that these are difficult times for some, and we understand if you are unable to support the church financially.
