- ◆ The Vestry approved the 2020 Parochial Report, containing statistical, financial, and demographic data that is submitted annually to our denominational offices.
- ◆ As of February 28, our year-to-date income is \$10,696 on a YTD budget of \$14,128. Year-to-date expenses as of February 28 are \$18,725 on a YTD budget of \$18,645. We currently have a year-to-date deficit of \$8,029. Thank you to all our members and friends for your generosity and faithful stewardship!
