Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the season of Lent. St James Episcopal Church will be joining with our siblings in faith from various churches to mark this special day. We are this year's hosts for the 16th annual ecumenical Ash Wednesday worship service on March 2 starting at 6:30PM (*no 4PM service that day*). Worship will include imposition of ashes, the symbolic reminder of our humanity and mortality: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

Dairy cows for Masvingo

Our companion diocese in Zimbabwe is starting a dairy farm. Since we are in Wisconsin (the "Dairy State"), it is appropriate for us to help! The Anglican Diocese of Masvingo will acquire 5 dairy heifers to add to the farm at Daramombe, where there is an Anglican school's campus in the middle of 1200 acres of school farmland. Each costs about \$2,000 with at least 5 needed to start a good herd. Can we build a herd? Our goal is to build the herd with every congregation providing support to the effort. So far our diocese has raised about \$7,900 or the \$10,000 needed. If you'd like to contribute toward this project, please label your gift "Cows" (checks may be made out to St James.)
