at our Cathedral in Fond du Lac 11AM on July 10

God willing and the people consenting, the Right Reverend Matthew A Gunter, Eighth Bishop of Fond du Lac, shall ordain Julia Roane Hendrix, David Brent Manley, and Jerome Peter Molitor to the Sacred Order of Priests in Christ's One Holy Catholic and Apostolic Church. The service begins at 11AM on Saturday, July 10 at the Cathedral of St Paul (51 W Division St, Fond du Lac). Your prayers and presence are requested. Reception to follow.

The Rev'd Deacon Jerry Molitor has been working with our congregation since September 2020. Jerry is a transitional deacon on the path to ordination as a priest in the Diocese of Fond du Lac. Jerry will continue to work with St James for several months after his ordination as a priest, as well as serving as a supply (substitute) priest for other churches. Jerry will likely be assigned to a church in our diocese in the Fall.

The July 10 ordination is a great opportunity to support and celebrate Jerry and the other ordinands, as well as a chance to visit our beautiful diocesan Cathedral!
