Pastoral letter from Amma Diane

Dear St James Community,

On Thursday May 14, the clergy of our Diocese met remotely with our Bishop Matt Gunter to discuss how we go forward as Christians, Episcopalians, and members of the Diocese of Fond du Lac in this continuing coronavirus pandemic. We have been meeting with the Bishop weekly since this all began. The Bishop also has been meeting once or twice a week with the diocesan Covid-19 Task Force to keep all of us as aware as possible of all we should or should not do during this epidemic as we continue to be the church in all the places we find ourselves.

Although the Supreme Court of the State of Wisconsin struck down the state's "Safer at Home" guidelines, which makes the possibility to open all of Wisconsin up again a reality, The Episcopal Church and the Diocese of Fond du Lac will not be "opening up" any time soon. This is also true of many other faith communities, businesses, and municipalities. Wisconsin is a "Home Rule State" so municipalities can set their own guidelines.

The leaders of our diocese and congregations will look at science and observable data as we seek to re-gather in person. Re-gathering will take place in phases and may be different in each of our locations and contexts. We will look to the guidance of our municipalities, and the medical professionals (such as the CDC) as we plan our re-gatherings. Some places that open may have to close again as the landscape changes. When we do re-gather it will not be the same as it was before Covid-19. There may be new guidelines: masks, sanitation to consider, seating arrangements, potentially no singing or Communion or Coffee Hour, etc.

There will be some grief and pain to be sure. When and how we re-gather will not be by vote of the congregation, but the clergy and leaders will continue to be in conversation with the congregation as we have been already in a variety of ways. We'll continue to share updates through *St James Weekly*.

For now at St James and most of the diocese and The Episcopal Church we will continue to do what we have been doing. We will lovingly take care of our neighbors and ourselves by being "Safer at Home". When we do begin to re-group in person we will also continue many of the new things we have done to stay together from a distance.

We continue to stay faithful to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. This is the Way of Love.

Vestry Updates

CARES Act charitable giving benefits

The CARES (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security) Act, signed into law on March 27, includes several provisions that benefit charitable giving. Beginning in 2020, individuals can deduct up to \$300 in charitable contributions from their gross income even if they do not itemize deductions. For 2020, the cap on itemized deductions for cash contributions is lifted, from 60% up to 100% of their income, a significant tax savings for anyone able to contribute larger amounts. Gifts of appreciated securities, and gifts to a donor advised fund or supporting organization, do not qualify for these benefits. These benefits are intended to encourage people to continue to support non-profit organizations, including churches, during the COVID-19 pandemic.
