The first step for those who need holiday help this year is to request it. Here's How:

Salvation Army (843) 524-3727

Monday, October 26 through Friday, October 30 - 9:00 AM -12 noon & 1:00 PM - 4:30 PM and conducted at the Salvation Army office located at 2505 North Street in Beaufort. Date and time slots for the toy shop will be provided during registration.

Requirements to receive toys – Valid photo ID or ITIN card, proof of residence (lease or electric bill), Birth certificate for all children under the age of 12, DSS Benefits report is helpful, custody papers if raising grandchildren, nieces/nephews, or foster children. ALL current income from all sources: ALL current expenses.

Love House Ministries will be conducting their registration process Monday - Friday from 12:30 –6:00pm from December 7th through December 11th. Registrations will be conducted online at www.LoveHouseMinistries.org
Requirements to receive assistance - Photo ID, proof of residence (lease or electric bill), SS card or birth certificate for each member of the household, proof of household income (check stubs if working or DSS printout if not), and all bills for the household.

Hilton Head Island Registration – Deep Well (843) 785-2849

Deep Well's **PHONE CALL ONLY** Registration Process starts Monday, November 2 and runs thru Thursday, December 10. Open to HHI residents with children ages 1-12 only. Call to register, 843-785-2849, M-F, 9 am – 5 pm. Required document is a current lease, if we do not already have one on file. Deep Well's Santa Shop will be open **with appointments** for parents to select toys Monday, Dec. 14 – Friday, Dec. 18, with Saturday Dec. 19 as an overflow day.

Requirements to receive toys – Current utility bill (electric, phone, water, or cable) with YOUR name and address on it, names, birthdates, and the school your children attend, and a valid phone number.

Bluffton Registration – Bluffton Self Help (843) 757-8000

Residents of Beaufort, Jasper and Hampton Counties may apply. Bluffton Self Help Registration will be held in a drive-thru format – behind Bluffton Self Help.

Mondays 3pm-6pm (Spanish Speaking Translators are available during this time frame ONLY)

Tuesdays – Fridays 10am – 1pm

Children Registration Ages Birth – 12 years old

Applicants must have:

Photo ID, Current Utility bill or 2020 Government benefit award letter, Birth Certificate(s) for any child/children that did not receive toys in 2019, If legal guardian, bring proof of guardianship or custodial papers

*** All locations will be following the CDC's guidelines and practicing Social Distancing.**

All registrants, volunteers and employees will be required to wear masks at Registration Sites.

For indoor registrations, one person per family is allowed only.

NO CHILDREN will be allowed at registration sites.
