

CSI: Identification of Schools

Which schools are eligible for CSI?

Type 1:

Lowest performing
5% of Title I schools



Type 2:

All high schools with graduation rates below 67%



How often are schools identified for CSI?

Identification process occurs once every three years

First identification based on 2018 Dashboard results



Schools can be identified for Support and Improvement in the following three categories:

- **CSI**--Comprehensive Support and Improve (criteria for lowest-performing school or graduation rate)
Dool Elementary and Aurora High School
- **TSI**--Targeted Support and Improvement
(None this year)
- **ATSI**--Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (category based on one or more student group(s) underperforming)
