ESTABLISH YOUR BUSINESS

There are several steps to ensuring a business is aligned with local, state, and federal regulations. Some companies will need additional requirements, depending on the type of business entity.

STATE CORPORATION COMMISSION

All corporations (foreign and domestic) and limited partnerships conducting business in Virginia must register with the Virginia State Corporation Commission. To become incorporated in Virginia, an organization must file trade names, DBA's, articles of incorporation, and amendments with the SCC. New businesses with trade names are also required to file with the Clerk of Circuit Court prior to applying for a business license. The Roanoke Regional SBDC (info above) can assist with this process at no additional charge.

FEDERAL EMPLOYER TAX ID

Federal Identification Numbers are required when you pay wages to one or more employees, or if your company is a partnership or corporation. Form SS-4 can be obtained from the IRS website above.

STATE TAX ID & SALES TAX

Businesses must apply for a State Identification Number from the Virginia Department of Taxation. Retail and wholesale companies must also register for sales tax.

SECURE A BUSINESS LOCATION

VERIFY LOCAL DEVELOPMENT REQUIREMENTS AND OBTAIN CO

Determine whether you need building, sign, or land disturbing permits, as well as utility services. After receiving appropriate approvals from the Community Development department, you will be issued a Certificate of Occupancy. With a CO, you can obtain a business license.
