Due to the pandemic, the LSS Food Pantry continues to limit number of volunteers per shift to three (9 am to 12 pm or 1 pm to 4 pm). Therefore, St. Luke cannot bring the 6 - 8 volunteers that were able to serve in 2019 and

through early March of 2020. However, volunteers are still needed if you are healthy and if you sign up in advance. Volunteers and staff must have their temperatures taken when they arrive and wear face overings. The morning shifts usually involve packing standard boxes, packing bread, or sorting produce.

The afternoon shifts typically involve distributing and restocking produce. The volunteer work can be tiring, but the LSS staff and clients are appreciative.

Clients come in the afternoon to pick up food and stay outside the building; nearly all wear masks.

Liquid Dish Soap (32 oz)
