#### **GLOBAL MESSENGER**

**Description:** Global Messengers are athlete ambassadors who foster awareness and advocacy for the Special Olympics movement. Athletes must complete a training program in communications, speech writing and presentations along with their local speech coach. Global Messengers are called upon to give presentations about their involvement with Special Olympics to various groups throughout the state with the goal of increasing awareness about the program. Interested athletes must have an identified person who is willing to volunteer as their Speech Coach, attend trainings and assist with preparation of speeches as needed.

#### **Responsibilities:**

Participate in a minimum of two Global Messenger training sessions in 2015 (dates available on www.soct.org) Present a minimum of two speeches (or attend two events) Meet with Speech Coach for speech preparation and practice at least once a month Assist with arrangement of speaking engagements and travel arrangements Respond to Global Messenger requests from SOCT in a timely manner Attend scheduled speeches and appearances and represent SOCT in a professional manner

#### **Qualifications:**

Commitment to and enthusiasm for the mission and philosophy of Special Olympics Athlete must participate in at least one SOCT sport annually Willingness to attend training and commit to practicing public speaking to improve skills Ability to travel Time to prepare and practice presentations Access to email

Speech Coach must have ability to work with Special Olympics athletes and be a registered Class A Volunteer

### UNIFIED GLOBAL MESSENGER TEAM

**Description:** A Unified Global Messenger Team consists of one Special Olympics athlete and one Unified Partner. They work together as a team to prepare and speak about Special Olympics Connecticut, informing the public about the mission, philosophy, and benefits of participation in our year-round sports program.

#### **Responsibilities:**

Participate in a minimum of two advanced Global Messenger training sessions in 2015 (dates available on www.soct.org) Present a minimum of two speeches (or attend two events) as a Unified Global Messenger team Work as a team to prepare for each presentation with a focus on sharing the perspective of both the athlete and partner Partner agrees to assist with speech preparation and practice, arrangement of speaking engagements, and travel arrangements Respond to Unified Global Messenger requests in a timely manner Attend scheduled speeches and appearances Represent Special Olympics Connecticut in a professional manner Qualifications:

Commitment to and enthusiasm for the mission and philosophy of Special Olympics Athlete must participate in at least one Special Olympics Connecticut sport annually; Partner must be a registered Class A volunteer Willingness to attend training and commit to practicing public speaking to improve skills Ability to travel Time to prepare and practice presentations
