What is an eResource?

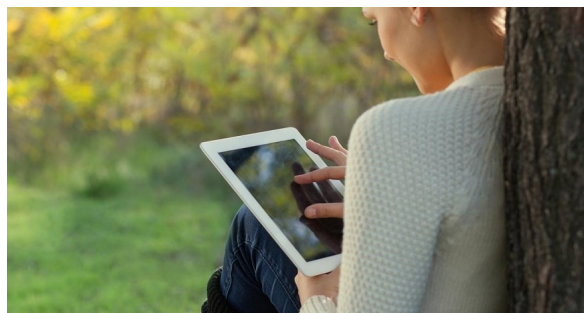
eResources are content and information sources that the library provides access to in an electronic format, arranged for quick and convenient searching.

How can I access eResources from Talbot County Free Library?

1. Go to the library's website: www.tcfl.org.
2. From the "FIND" tab at the top of the page, click on "eResources."
3. Find the eResource you'd like to search by clicking the subject heading or the eResource name.
4. If prompted, type in your library card number (all 14 digits under the barcode.)
