- 1. Workshops** Workshop attendance is first-come, first served. We do not have pre-registration. We encourage attendees to select a first- and second-choice workshop in case the first option is full upon arrival.

Once your award has been approved in the EIP portal, please register for the conference online. The entire process is now virtual.


Please note: Package A is not available on-site, and on-site registration prices will be at an increased rate.

**EIP Cancellation Policy:** If you have been issued an EIP award and do not attend the conference (and have not cancelled by March 4), you are responsible for payment of your registration fees.

## Covid-19 Policies

NYAEYC is guided by recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and will abide by the legal mandates of Turning Stone.
