LWVUS / LWV WI Redistricting <i>Congressional districts and government legislative bodies should be apportioned substantially on population. We oppose partisan and racial gerrymandering that strips rights away from voters. We promote transparent and accountable redistricting processes and to end hyper-partisan practices that don't benefit constituents. We believe responsibility for fair redistricting should be vested in an independent special commission, with membership that reflects the diversity of the unit of government</i>	--Advocacy for state legislation --Census issues -- advocacy to insure all persons are counted -- "Politics of Resentment": rural/ urban/ suburban impact on politics
