WORSHIP & HOSPITALITY

- We averaged 357 people in-person on Sundays, in addition to special worship services such as Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, plus Easter Sunrise service at Gilchrist Park, and 2 Christmas Eve services, which totaled over 20,589 in worship for the year.
- We had 2,289 online worship views for 2024.
- We received 32 new members through Profession of Faith or Re-Affirmation of Faith, plus 11 who joined by transfer from other Christian churches
- We had 4 baptisms.
- We partnered with YoungLife (high school) and WyldLife (middle school) to bring teens to faith in Jesus Christ.
- We helped the Fellowship of Christian Athletes.
- We offered "First Steps" classes to introduce people to New Life Church, and to help them get to know the ways they can grow in their relationship with Christ.





SHAPING

Children, Youth and Adults into the likeness of Jesus through...

- Prayer over the many concerns of our church, community, nation and world by the members of the Tuesday morning prayer group and the Thursday noon prayer group; 24/7 prayer during Holy Week in 2024.
- 315 people in spiritual formation groups, including:
- Sunday School for children, youth, and adults.
- Weekday Bible Studies for youth and adults.
- Small groups at home and on-campus for spiritual growth of youth and adults.
- The music which aided in our traditional worship included the handbell choir, Chancel Choir, ensembles, and other special music; all under the leadership of Director of Traditional Music, MaryBeth Khamis; in addition, the contemporary Worship Team was led by Worship Leader, Daniel Candia.





SENDING

missionaries out in the love of Christ... by partnering with...

- 8 different missions funded at \$74,590.
- 3 Cuba mission trips, total given \$22,530.
- YoungLife, total given \$41,416.
- Valerie's House, a ministry to children and family who have lost loved ones.
- Residing Hope Children's Home, \$11,702 given.
- Youth summer mission trip to Mescalero, New Mexico for 9 days.
- Operation Christmas Child, sponsored by our United 4 Him youth ministry, sent over 327 boxes to share the love and the Gospel of Jesus Christ around the world.
- Ministry with the Homeless such as Shower Ministry, partnering with St. Vincent de Paul and Jesus Loves You Ministries, along with Feed the Harbor to stock local food pantries.
- Bountiful Blessings food distribution each Friday to those in need, serving 150+ families each week.
- Our free Community Thanksgiving Dinner fed over 300 people; dozens of people gave hundreds of hours as they rang the bell for Salvation Army's Red Kettle collection at Christmas.
- We provided gifts, love, and Christmas dinner to 24 families through the Foster Children's Network including over 100 children.
- Monthly Birthday lunches for Crossroads Hope Academy.
- GriefShare provided ministry to people grieving the loss of a loved one.
- Cancer Support Ministry provided support for caregivers and those on a cancer journey.
- Today Matters Mental Health prayer team providing weekly visits to Charlotte Behavioral Health Crisis Unit to offer prayer to those in need.


