REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS

The Learning Hubs Expansion Fund is a grant program for operators of supportive spaces for socioeconomically disadvantaged students engaged in distance learning.

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- **Nonprofit or public entity** (e.g. city or school district) located in San Mateo County
- Serve primarily students whose annual family income is **less than 80% of the Area Median Income** (AMI) and, if funded, will increase learning hub slots for these students
- **Currently operate a learning hub** (or operated a learning hub during the 2020-2021 school year) as defined below:
 - Serve **K-12 students** whose schools are expected to remain in distance learning (including hybrid models with a distance learning element) due to COVID-19
 - Operate during traditional K-12 **school hours**
 - Provide students **free access to WiFi**
 - Include **on-site adult supervision** to support learning and assist with student technology needs
 - Allow for **COVID-19-safe socialization** with peers.

The application opens **Wednesday, January 27** at 9am. All applications must be received by **Wednesday, February 10** at 5pm.
